



Unincorporated County Stormwater Capture Project Gates Canyon Park

○ **Project Scope**

To divert urban and stormwater runoff from local unincorporated communities for groundwater infiltration and landscape irrigation reuse. The project will also include Low-Impact-Development landscaping features and educational signage.

○ **Project Benefits**

The project will improve water quality by reducing pollutants such as bacteria from entering Malibu Creek and the ocean and provide an alternate source of water for irrigating the County park facility.

- Total Project Cost: \$9.0M
- Drainage Area: 100% UA
- Volume Capture: 3.1 Acre-Feet

- June 2019 – Construct Project
