# PARTIAL FUNDING OVERVIEW

## Purpose

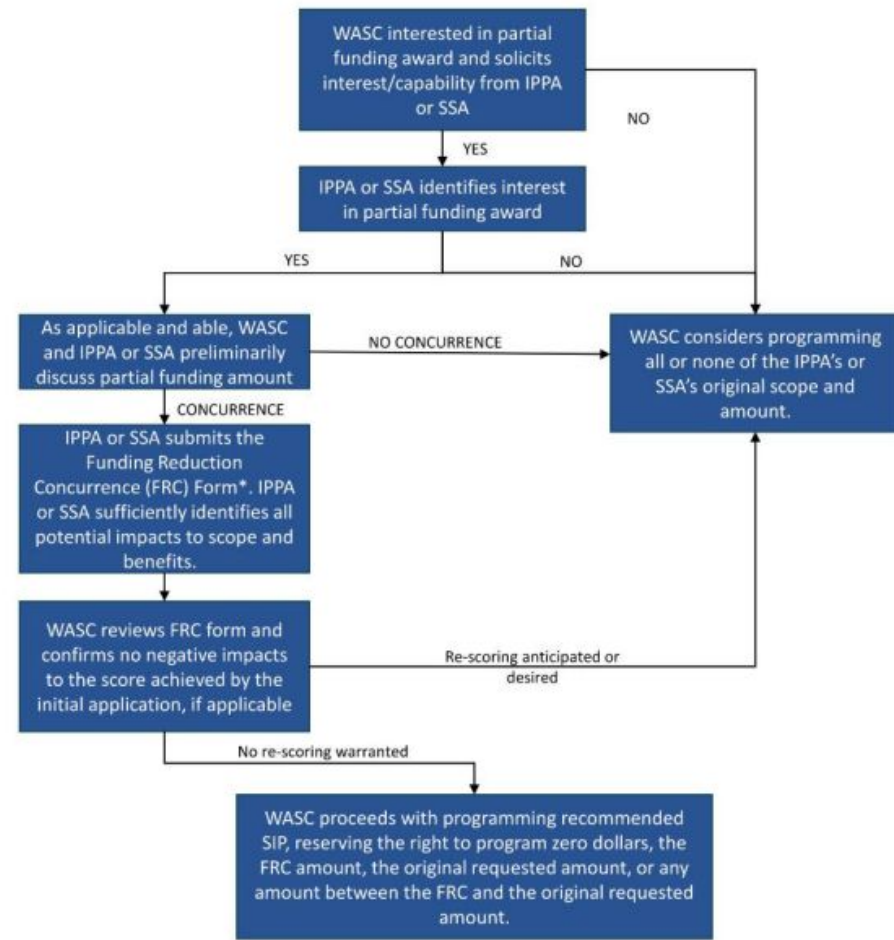
- Supports **adaptive management** of the SCWP by providing flexibility in SIP development
- Allows WASCs to **recommend funding amounts less than requested by Program applicants** (for the current budget year or future projections)

## Eligibility

- Current SIP cycle applicants – **Infrastructure Project or Scientific Study**
- Applicant must demonstrate willingness & ability to **complete the full project** or study scope identified in the application.

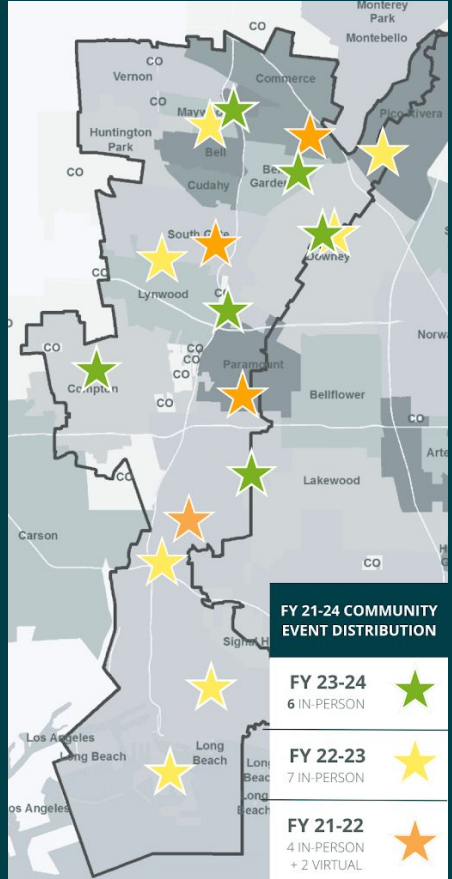
# PROCESS

1. WASC **solicits interest**/capability from the applicant
2. WASC and applicant **discuss partial funding amount**
3. Applicant submits the **Funding Reduction Concurrence (FRC) Form**
  - a. Applicant identifies all potential impacts to scope & benefits
4. WASC reviews FRC form and confirms no **negative impacts to applicant's initial score**
  - a. If re-scoring: WASC considers programming all or none of the applicant's original scope and amount
  - b. If no re-scoring is needed, WASC proceeds with programming the recommended SIP



\* - FRC form is due at least one week before the WASC meeting. WASC to defer further discussion regarding programming the subject project or study in the recommended SIP until next meeting

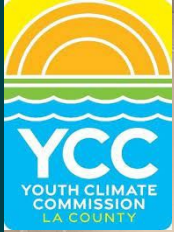

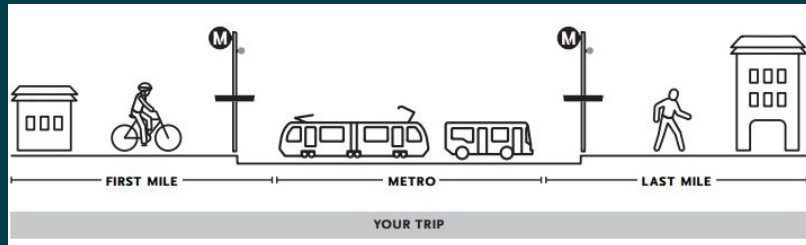
