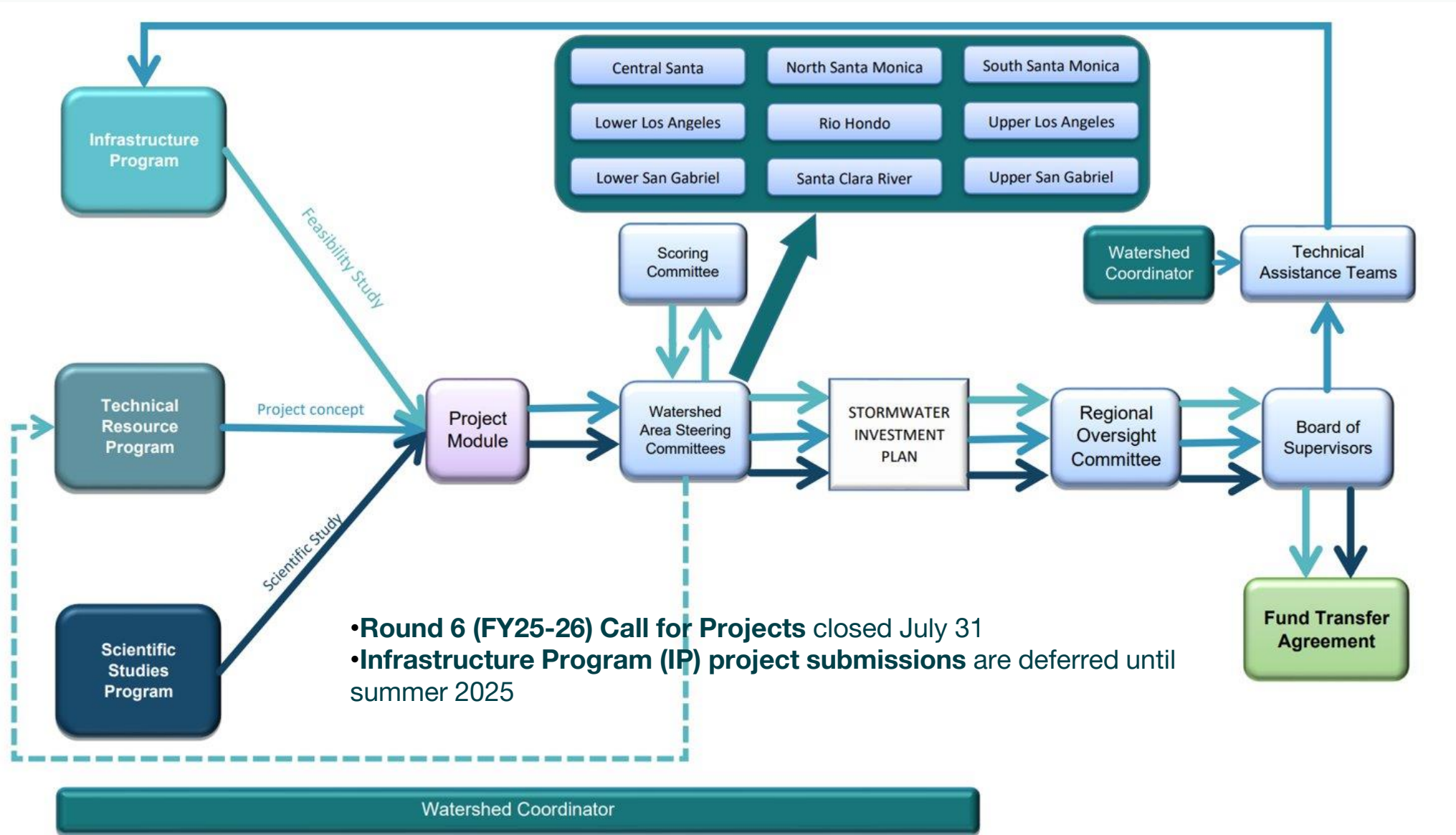

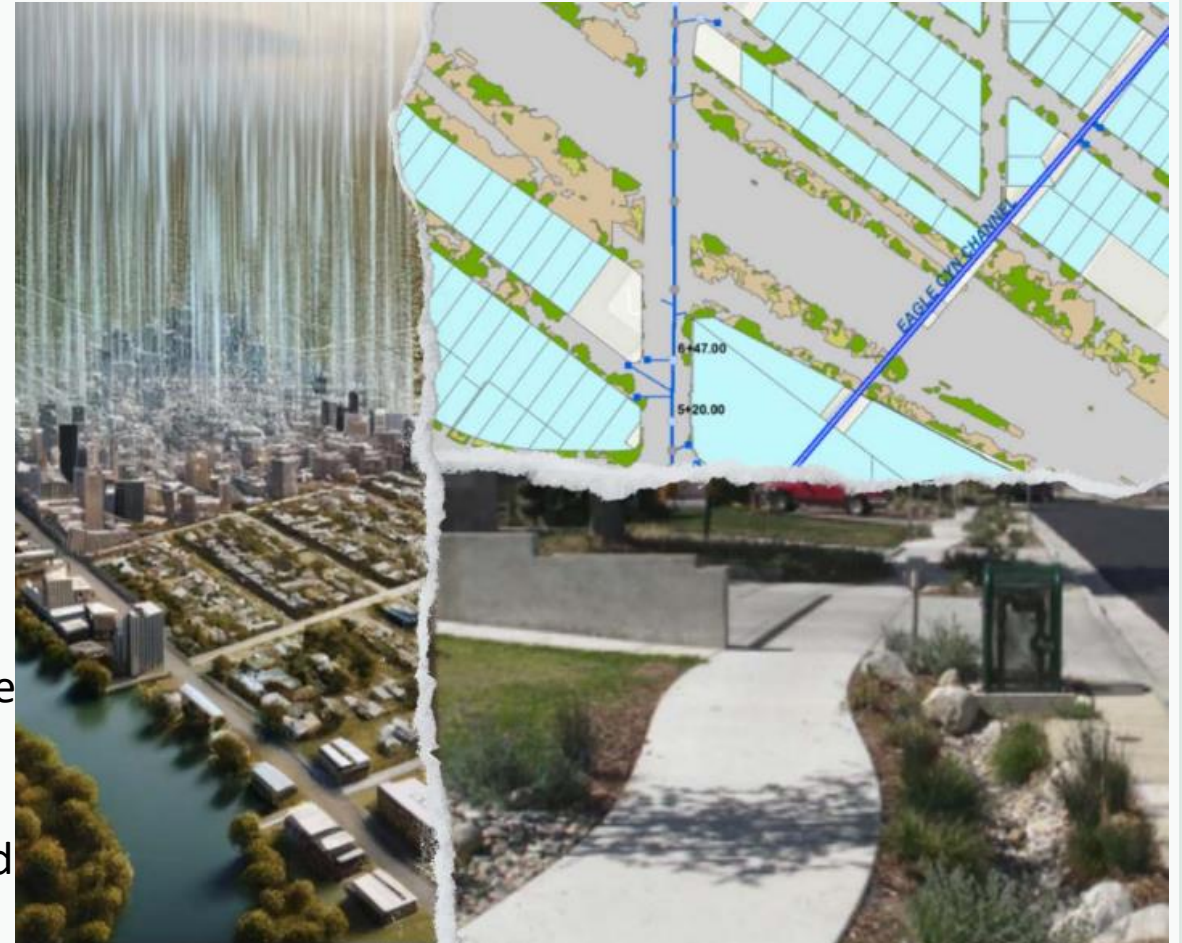
# Regional Program Flow Chart



## Project Background

### Data-Driven Resource Optimization and Planning System (DROPS) for Los Angeles County

- Scientific Study Lead- Foothill Municipal Water District
  - Study Collaborators- Crescenta Valley Water District, Glendale Water and Power, Pasadena Water and Power
  - Study Developer- California Data Collaborative
- Location – all 9 watershed areas
- Total Requested Funds \$442,000
  - \$49,111 from SSMB for FY25-26
- Water quality benefits- primary pollutants of concern can be treated at the ID'd LID project site
- Water supply benefits- ID sites for efficient groundwater recharge throughout the County
- MWD funded a pilot DROPS tool for the Raymond and Verdugo Groundwater Basins



## Project Background

### DepaveLA: Prioritizing Parking Lots for Green Retrofitting

- Scientific Study Lead- Council for Watershed Health
  - Study Collaborator- Olaunu (Daniel Apt)
  - Study Developer- Herrera
- Location- CSMB, USGR, SSMB, RH, LSGR
- Total requested funds- \$1,088,720
  - SSMB- \$115,592 in years 1 &2
- Water quality benefits- reduction of pollution generating surfaces with green infrastructure
- Water supply benefits- decrease of impervious area and increased site infiltration
- Community investment benefits- nature-based solutions, habitat connectivity, partner with community for safety improvements, etc.
- Cited the Hermosa Beach Multi-Benefit Parking Lot Greening project as a demonstration project (permeable pavers, native vegetation bioswales, community multi-use benefits)
