



• Save Elephant Hill TRP funded in RD6


### **SCWP Public Education and Community Engagement Grants Program**

• Provide guidance and technical assistance to develop proposals to interested parties, incl. CBOs and non-profits










## What issues are of greatest concern in your community? (Select all that apply).





