Sourcing New Projects

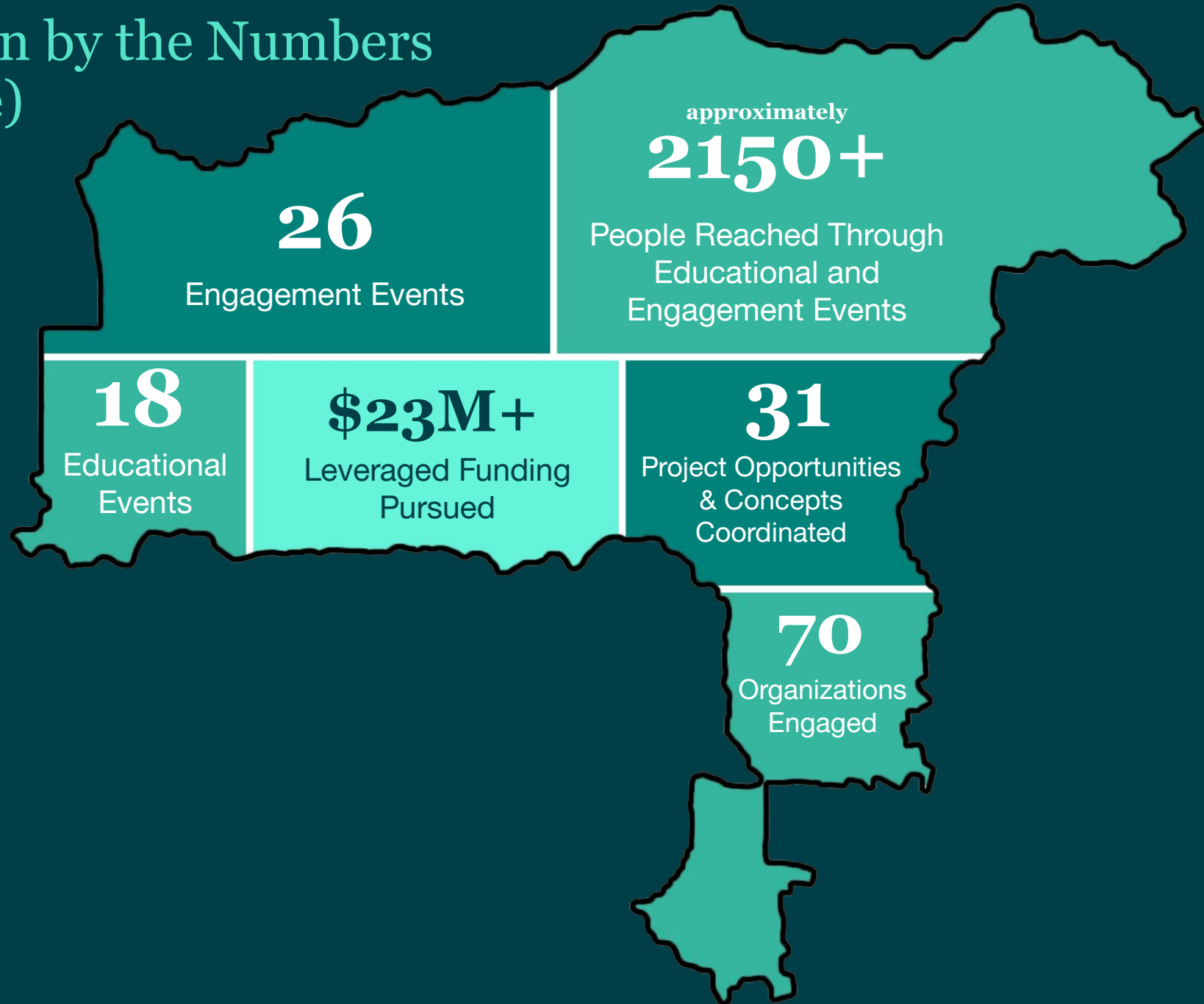

- Provide guidance and technical assistance to develop proposals to interested parties, incl. CBOs and non-profits



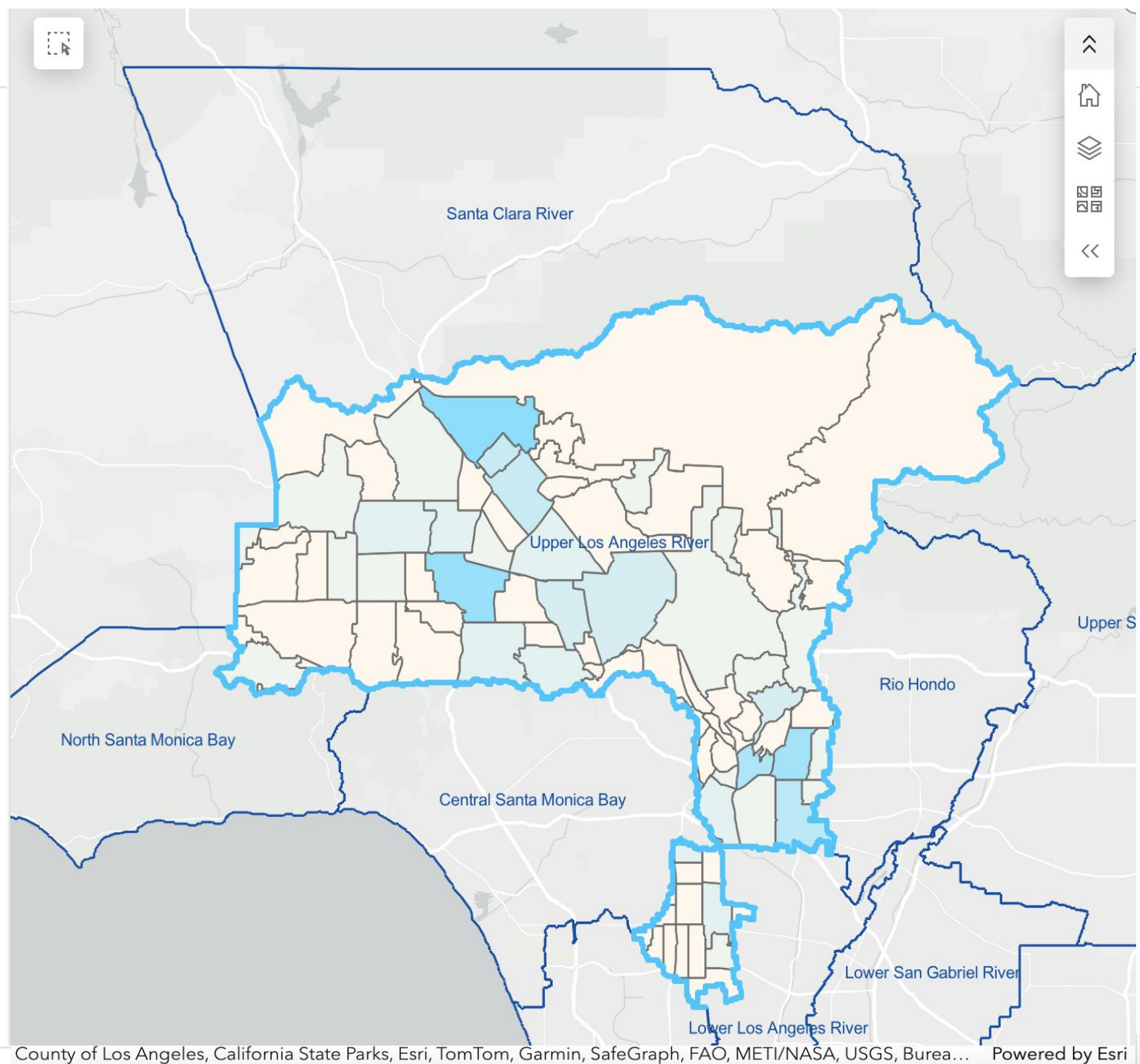

TOTAL SURVEYS



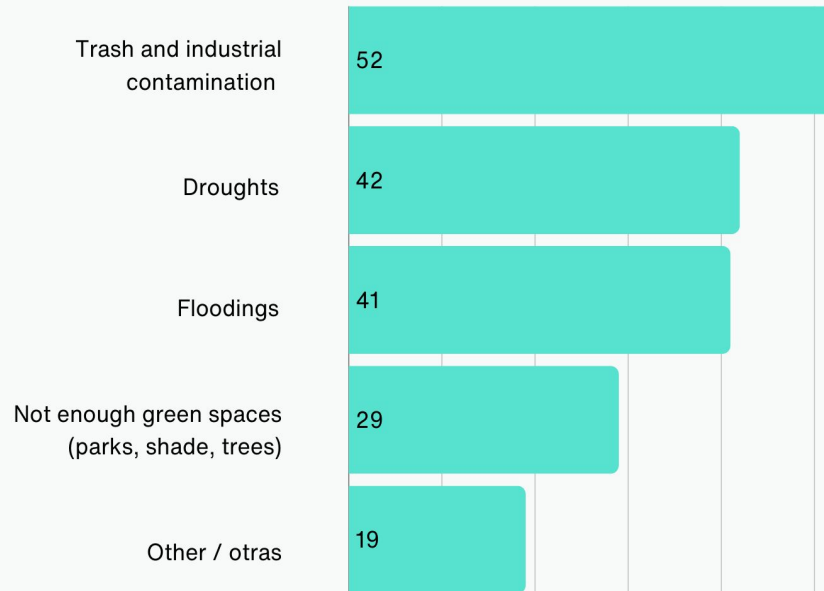

(Select all that apply).

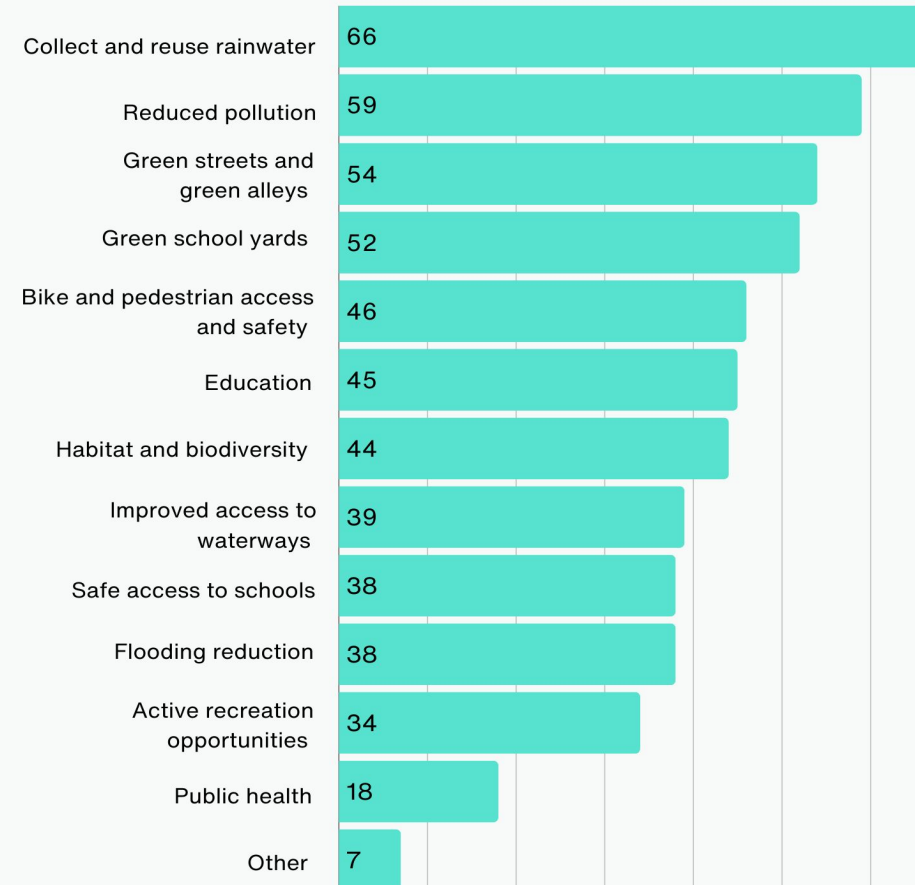

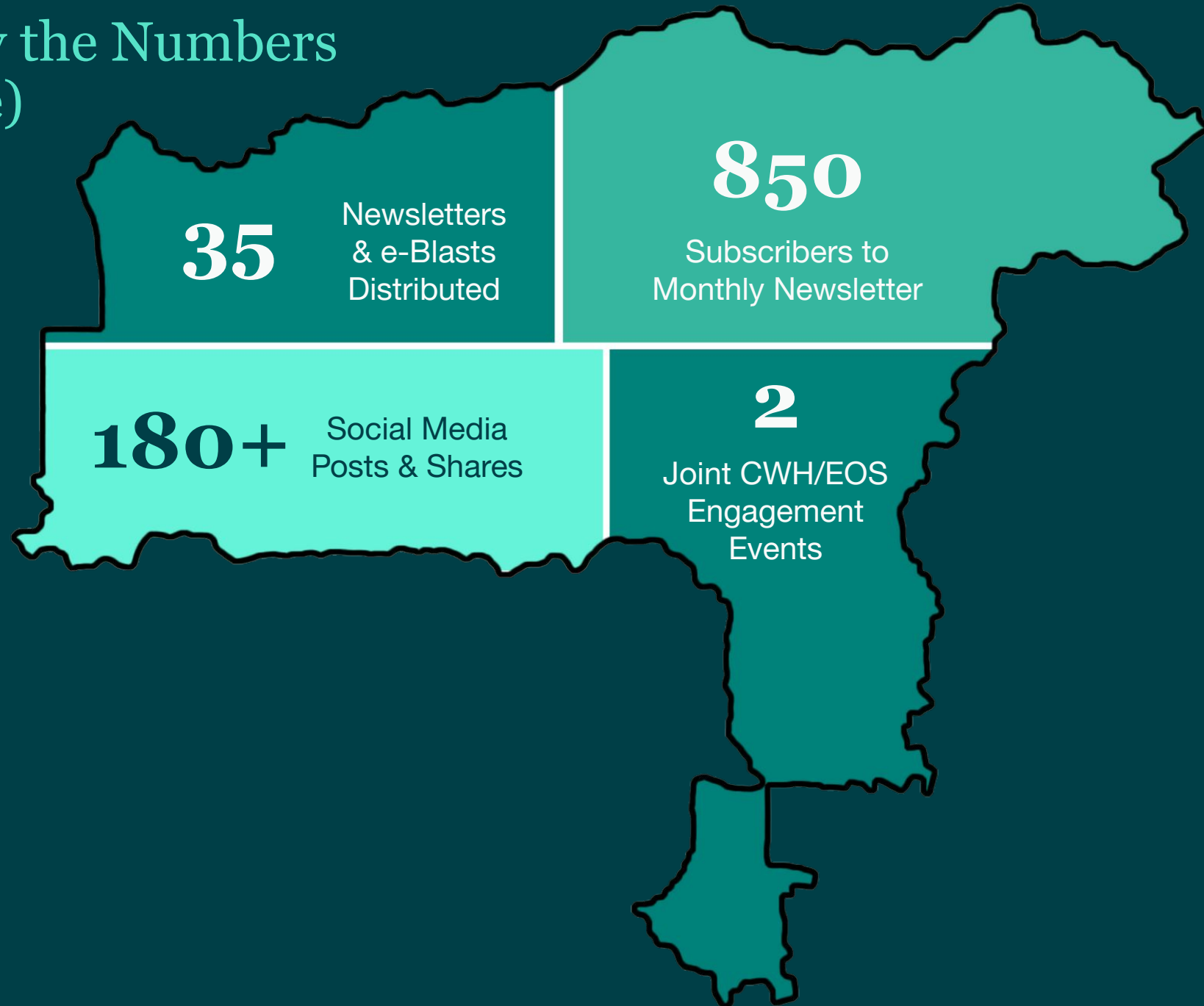
What improvements would you like to see in your community? (Select all that apply)

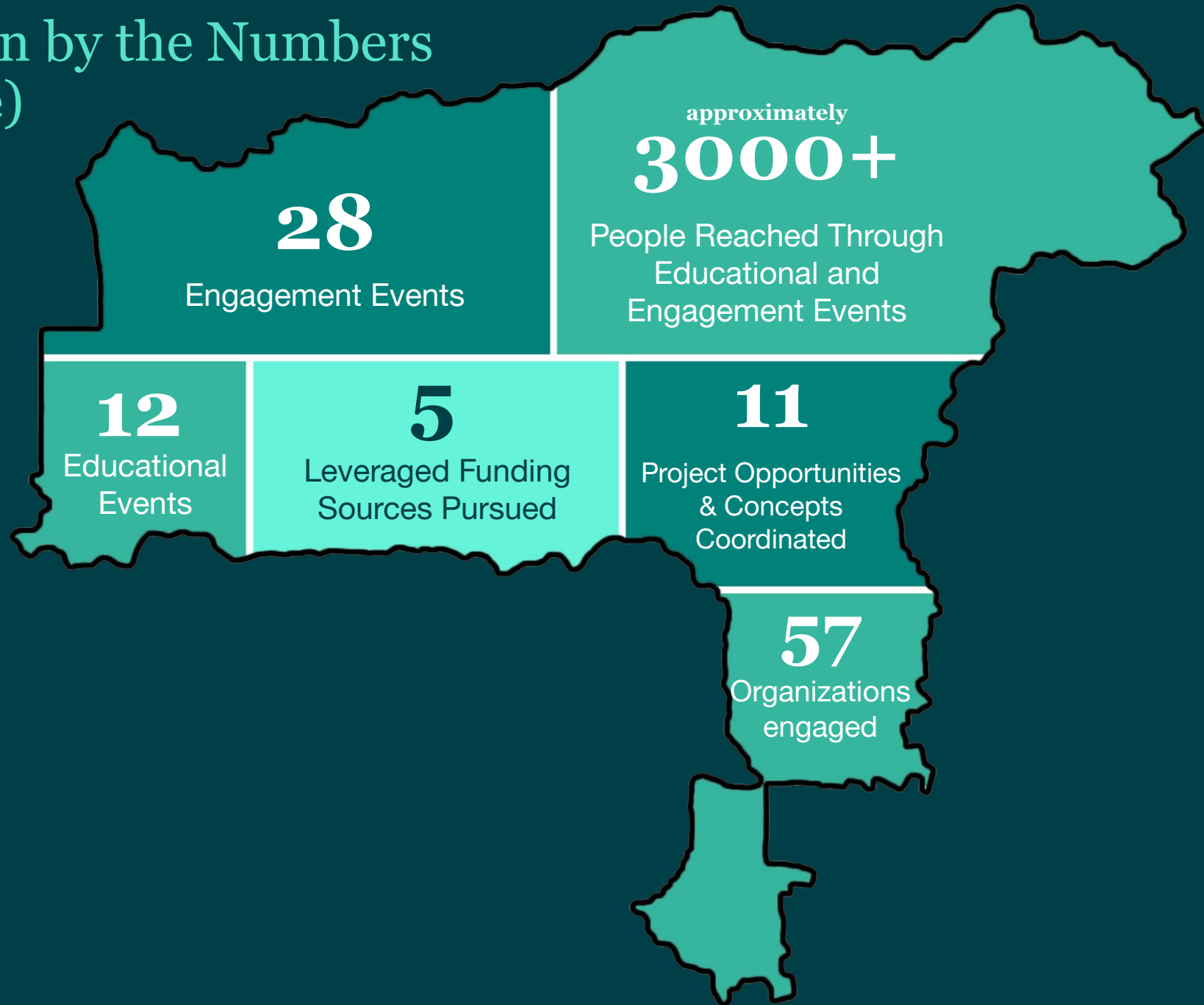
