

Mapping Data Sources:


<u>California School Campus Database</u> - a GIS data set that contains detailed outlines of the lands used by public schools for educational purposes.

<u>Tree Canopy by Census Tract - Overview</u> - created by the LA County Internal Services Department to support the Chief Sustainability Office Community Forestry Management Plan.

LAUSD Land Cover Data - publicly available land cover data from LAUSD

In Process:

- Identifying land cover for all other school districts in LLAR
- Looking into geospatial water capture data, diversion maps, and any other available data
