
#### SCWP Draft Initial Watershed Plans Now Available!

The Safe, Clean Water Program (SCWP), adopted in 2018, advances stormwater projects that improve water quality, increase local water supply, and provide community benefits, like green spaces and parks in LA County. The SCWP is implemented through 9 regions called Watershed Areas. To help accomplish SCWP goals, *Draft Initial Watershed Plans* for the 9 watershed areas have been developed.

The *Draft Initial Watershed Plans* outline clear regionwide and Watershed Areaspecific targets and needs, efforts to date, and highlight strategies and opportunities to guide future investments. To ensure community input, all 9 *Draft Initial Watershed Plans* have been made available for review and public comment.

All *Plans*, including the Upper San Gabriel Watershed Plan can be found on the Watershed Planning page of the SCWP website. Community members can submit comments using this <u>Public Comment Form</u> during the open public comment period from August 14 to September 28, 2025.
