Purpose of SCW Program Biennial Progress Report



• Summarizes Regional, Municipal, and District Reports

 Makes findings regarding whether and the extent to which SCW Program requirements were met and SCW Program Goals were achieved



Data & Information Included in the 2026 Biennial Progress Report



Reported Data - July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2024

• Reviews and evaluates the first four complete fiscal years of SCWP data, building on the 2024 Biennial Report with <u>last</u> <u>two complete fiscal years</u> of reported data.

Adaptive Management – To Date



• Reflects on and considers all efforts and adaptive management actions undertaken, <u>with emphasis on most recent activities</u>.






