Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)



General Questions

- **Where can Project Developers find key dates such as application deadlines?**
 - Key dates can be found on the [Safe, Clean Water \(SCW\) Program Website](#). Interested parties can check the Regional Program and Municipal Program pages for more information about upcoming deadlines.
- **What type of entities are able to apply for Projects? Do you have to be a developer or municipality, or can individuals or groups (say a group of residents) apply?**
 - Anyone with the capability to develop a Project may apply to the SCW Program. The Program is open to all Project developers and is not limited to a specific list of developers or municipalities.
 - There are three subtypes of applications for the Regional Program
 - The Infrastructure Program funds multi-benefit Infrastructure Projects that have completed a Feasibility Study.
 - The Technical Resources Program provides resources to community groups, municipalities, and individuals who need technical assistance to develop their Project Concepts into Feasibility Studies.
 - The Scientific Studies Program funds scientific and technical activities related to increasing Stormwater or Urban Runoff capture and/or reducing Stormwater or Urban Runoff Pollution

Feasibility Study Guidelines (FSG) 20th Requirement

- **Will the Project Module for Regional Program Projects now require alignment with the Watershed Plans?**
 - Yes, there will be a new tab added to the Project Module for Watershed Planning Alignment that will follow the format of the Mockup provided in the presentation.
- **Will the new FSG 20th Requirement be required by Call for Projects 2026 or 2027?**
 - Projects applying by the July 31st, 2026 deadline will have to comply with the new FSG 20th Requirement and describe alignment with the Watershed Plans.
- **Will the new FSG 20th Requirement be required for Projects that have already received funding?**
 - No, Projects that have already submitted their application and are currently funded by the SCW Program will not have to retroactively fill out that field in their application.
 - If Projects that have already received funding decide to seek new funding, they will have to abide by the new 20th requirement.
- **When will the Projects Module be updated to reflect the new FSG 20th Requirement?**
 - The Projects Module will be updated in May 2026 prior to the 2026 Call for Projects period.
 - A Call for Projects Info Session will also take place in May and provide more information on the new 20th Requirement.

Watershed Planning Tool

- **When dropping a pin, does it provide the address of the location identified?**
 - When dropping a pin within the Online Planning Tool, the pin's latitude and longitude are provided. Developers may use this information to identify their Project site.
- **Can you find a Project by typing a specific address?**
 - The Online Planning Tool does not allow users to search for parcel specific addresses. However, if you know the general location of your Project, you may view that area within the Planning Tool.
- **Will there be any Info Session or Recording Sessions for applicants about the Online Planning Tool?**
