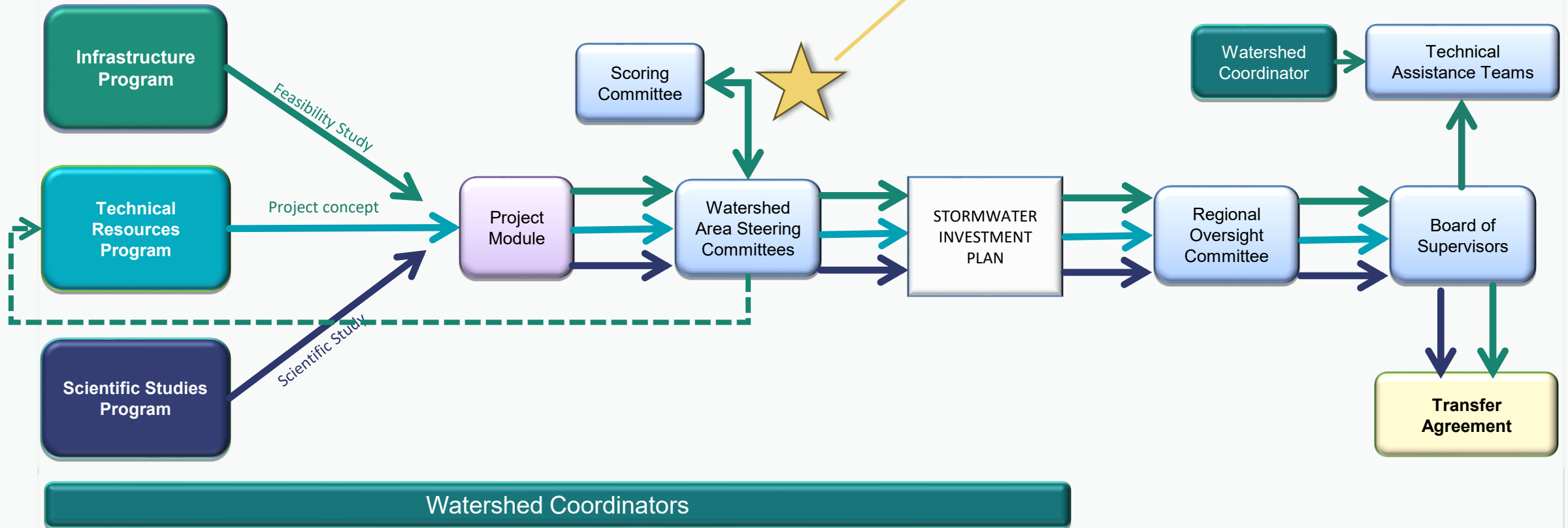

Goals:

1. Encourage WASC members to review applications
2. Familiarize WASC members with the range of submitted projects
3. Support WASCs' authority to decide which Projects to send to the Scoring Committee

Herondo Subwatershed Joint Distributed Infiltration and Green Street Project

Project Lead: City of Hermosa Beach

This is a TMDL-driven distributed infiltration project to capture runoff from the Herondo subwatershed with street greening and park enhancements.

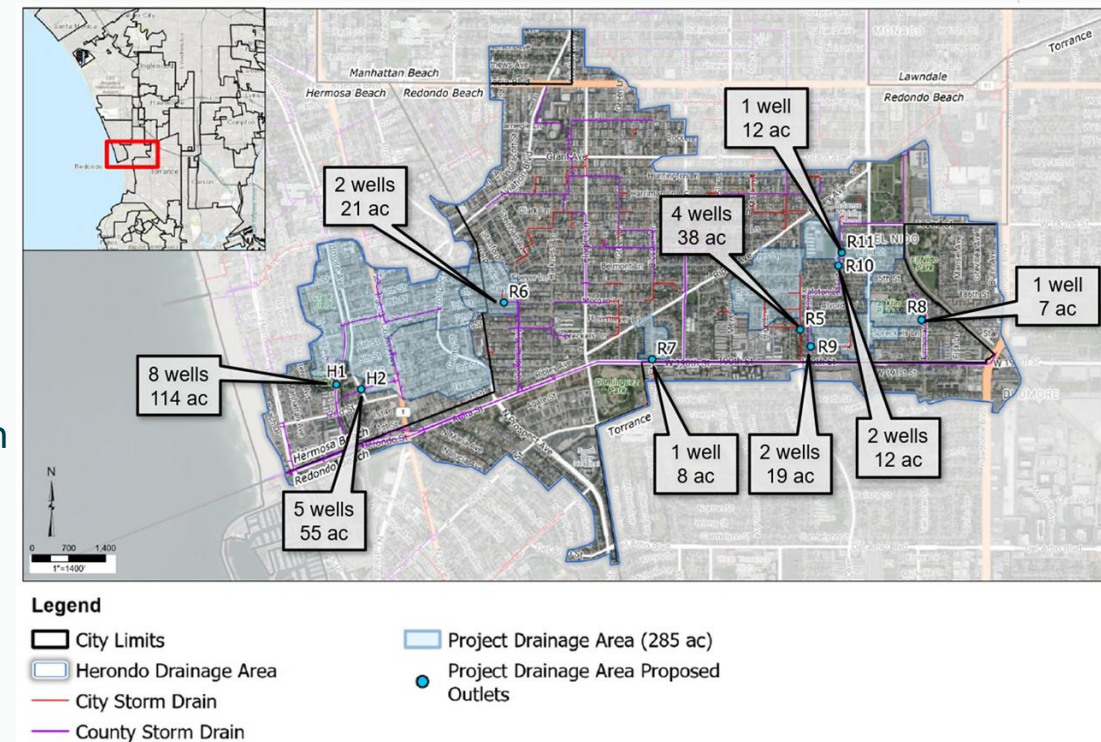
Collaborators: *City of Redondo Beach*

Location: *425 Valley Dr, Hermosa Beach CA*

Timeline: *Design complete 8/2028, Construction complete 9/2030*

Key Highlights

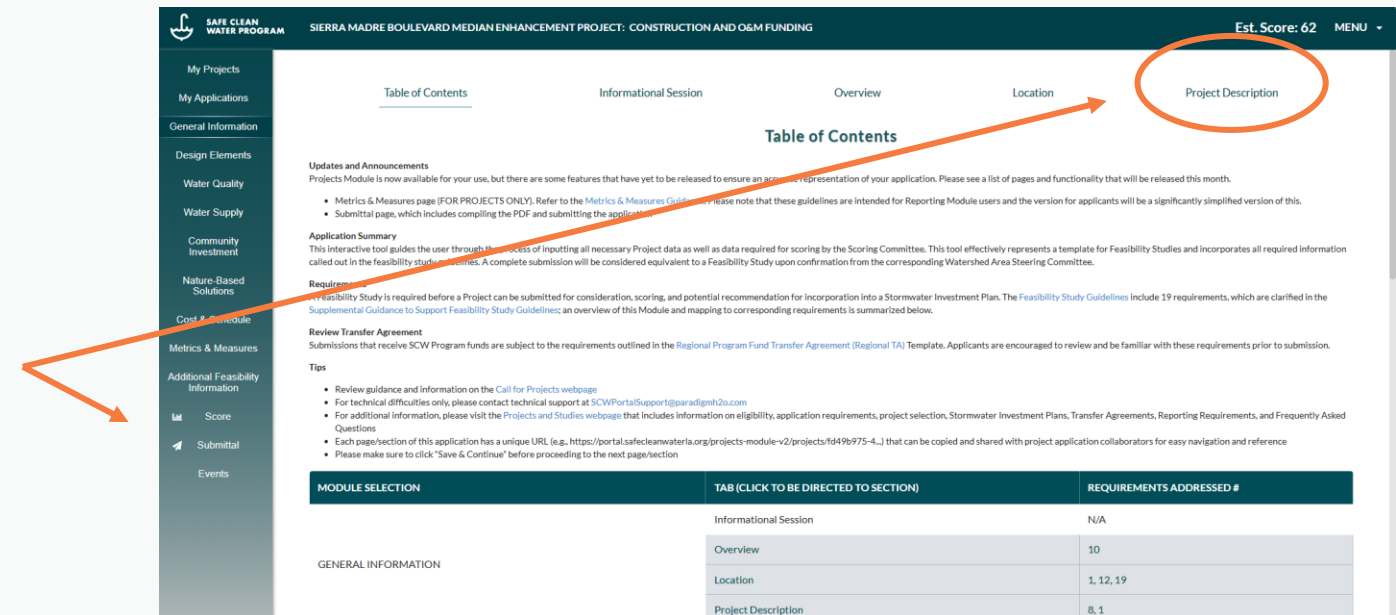
- 9 drywell infiltration systems (26 drywells) that will capture surface runoff and storm drain flows via diversion
- 48 lbs/yr Zinc load reduction, 40 lbs/yr Phosphorous load reduction
- 30 acre feet of runoff infiltrated/year
- Enhances local green space and reduces urban heat impacts
- 80% pollutant reduction for total Nitrogen and bacteria
- 20,000 sq ft of shrubs and grasses planted in bioswales
- Removal of 8,700 sq ft of impervious surface
- Wells sited in locations with a history of localized flooding
