



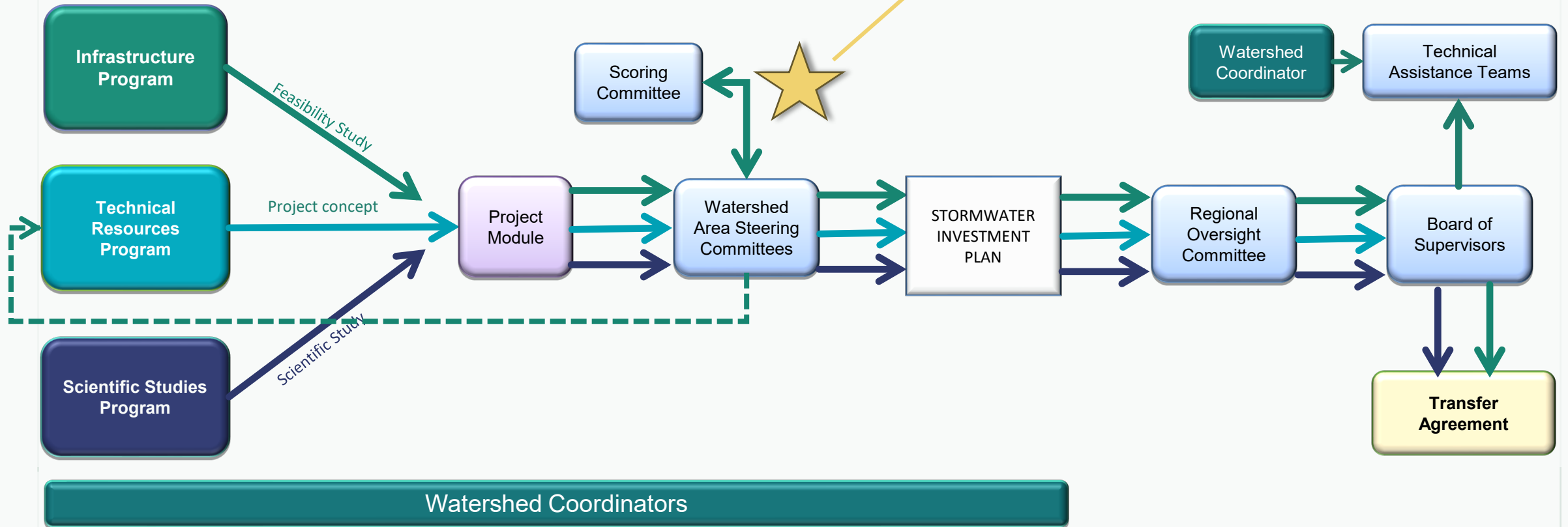

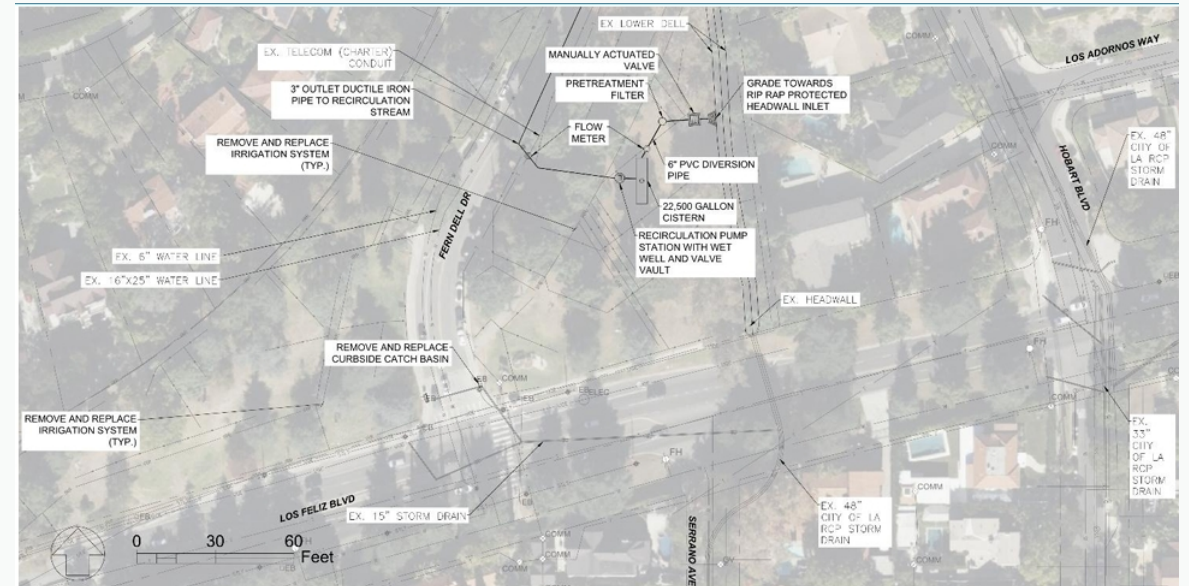

Key Highlights

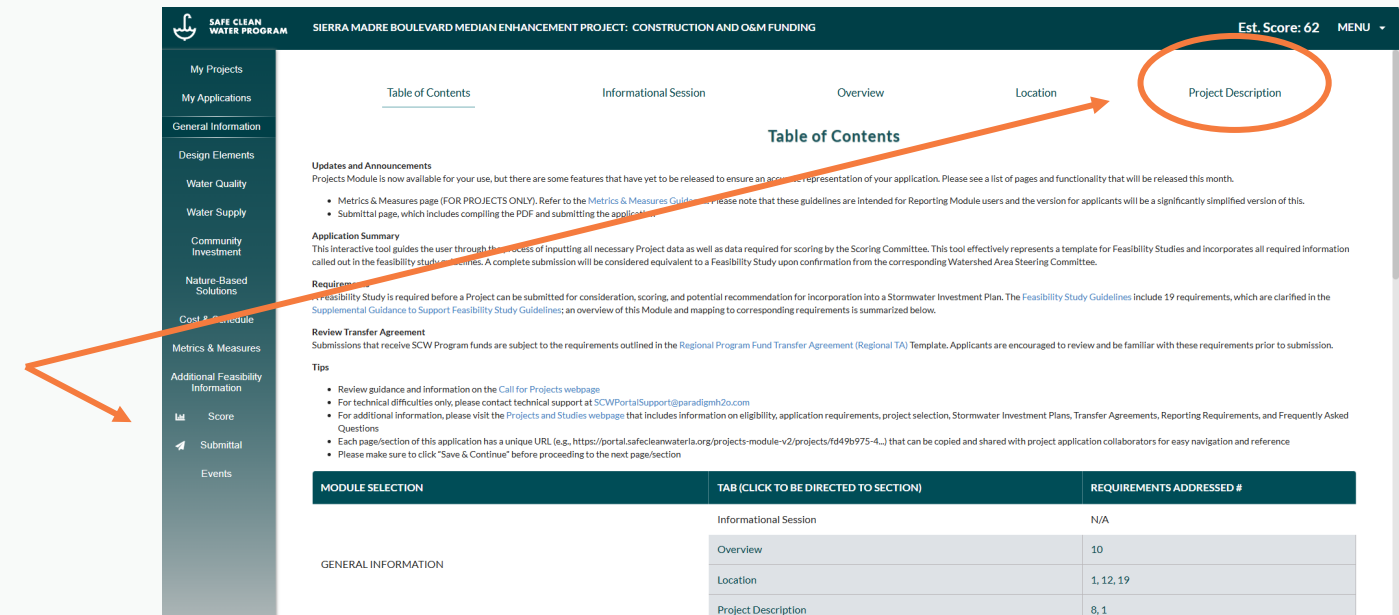
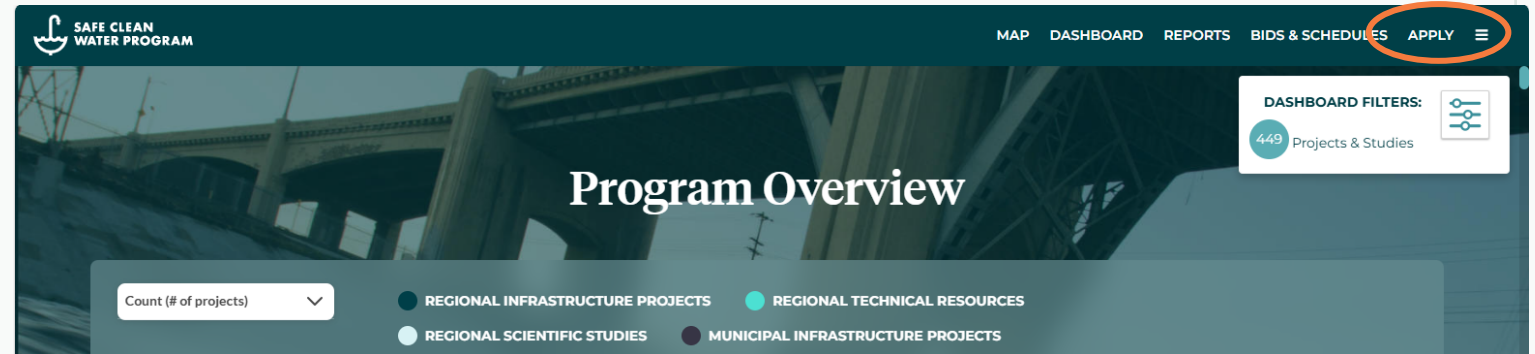
- Captures stormwater from a 336-acre drainage area
- 22,500-gallon cistern with upstream media filter pretreatment unit
- Will restore creek flood resilience by retrofitting culverts and catch basins
- Project will remove sediment, metals, trash, and other pollutants from runoff
- Provides flood management, urban heat island, water quality, environmental education, ADA accessibility, and recreation benefits to the public
- Creek restoration will restore native fern populations, plant new trees, improve habitat, and protect park biodiversity
- 10+ outreach activities held to inform public and gather feedback
- This was a previous TRP project
