



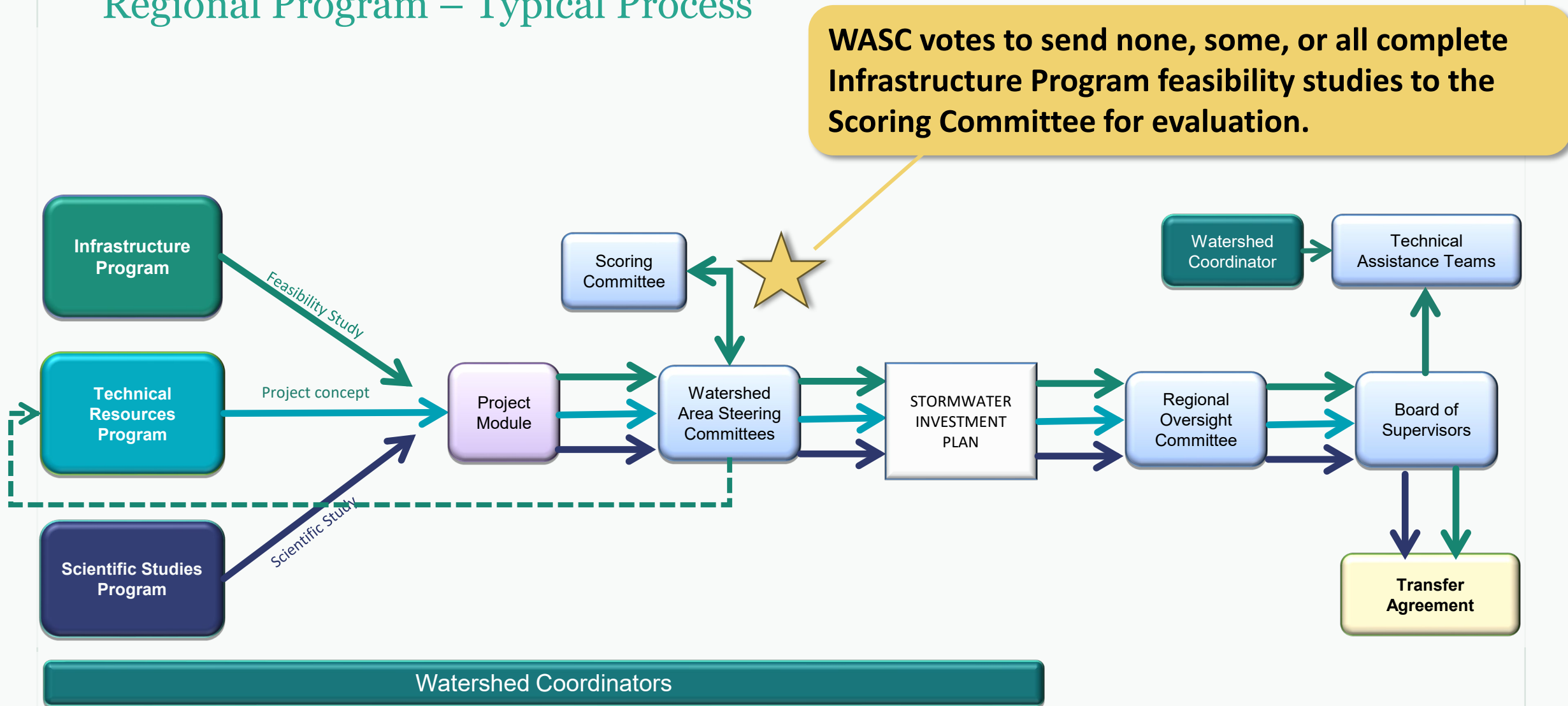

Washington Park Stormwater Capture Project

Project Lead: City of Pomona

Stormwater treatment and surface improvements (including new and enhanced amenities as well as additional shading and native vegetation)

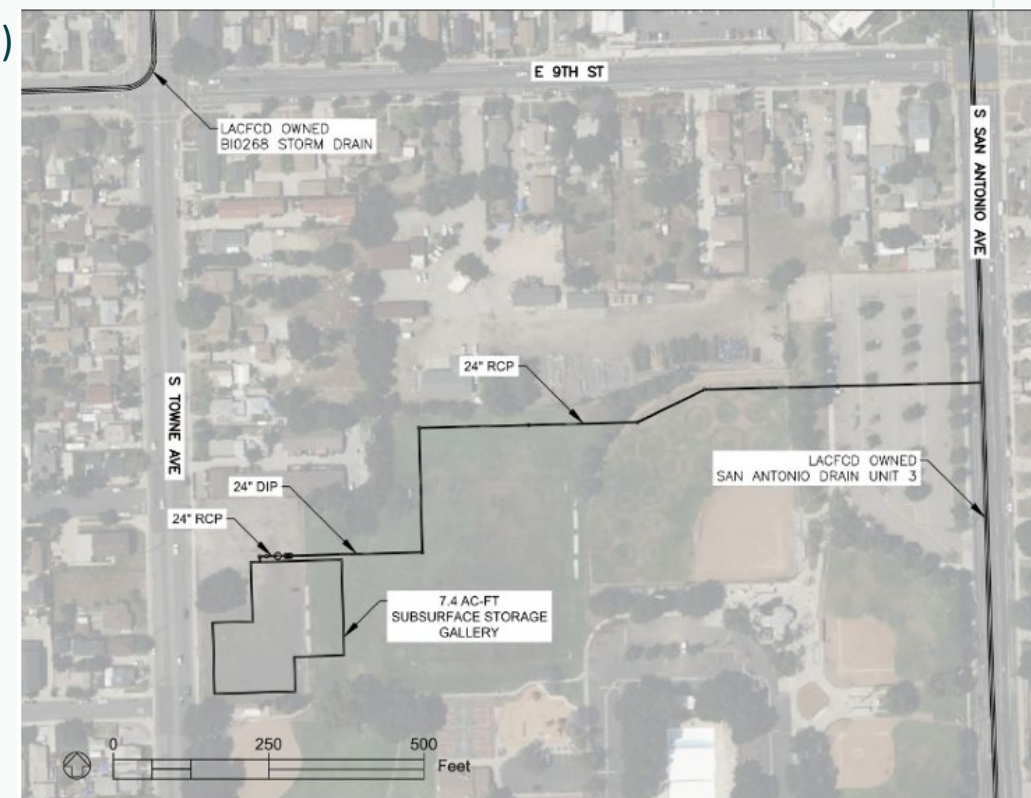

Location: 865 E Grande Ave, Pomona, CA

Timeline: Design complete 3/2029, Construction complete 3/2031

Key Highlights

- 78 average annual acre-feet of stormwater captured and infiltrated
- 7.4 acre-feet infiltration gallery constructed below parking lot to capture stormwater
- Captures and treats runoff to reduce pollutant and bacteria levels
- Park enhancements will include new trees, shade improvements, a permeable parking lot, and recreational amenities
- Engagement efforts have included 5 community events, neighborhood canvassing, and a survey
- 5 letters of support from community groups
- Provides benefits to disadvantaged communities



Total funding request: \$1,400,000 (Design Only)

Larkin Park

Project Lead: City of Claremont

This project proposes an infiltration gallery and bioswale at Larkin Park to improve water quality and enhance local water supply.

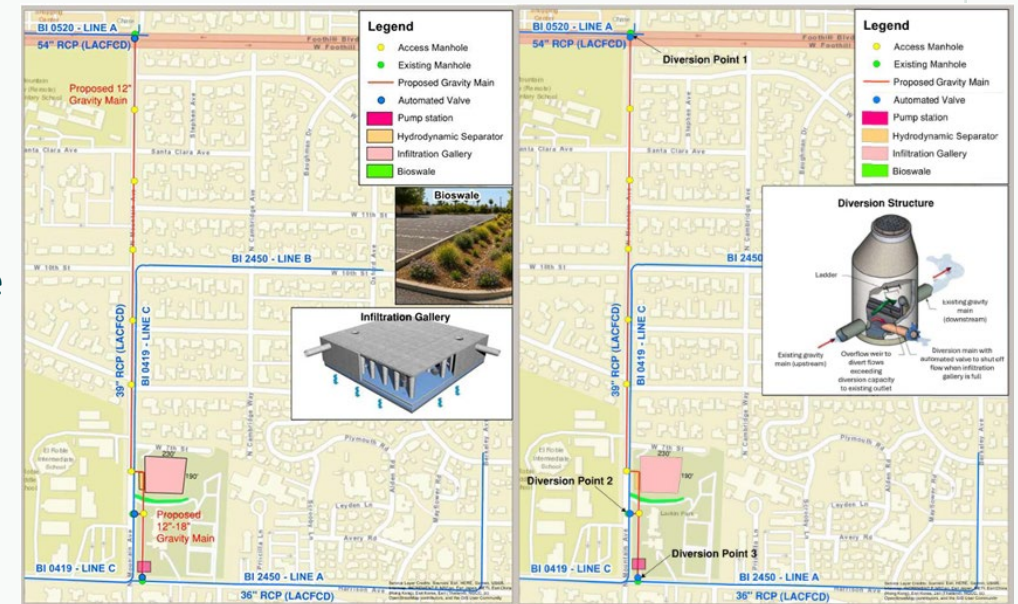
Collaborators: N/A

Location: 660 N Mountain Ave, Claremont, CA

Timeline: Design complete 12/2028, Construction complete 6/2030

Key Highlights

- 18 average annual acre-feet stormwater captured for aquifer recharge
- Reduces Zinc by 69 lbs/yr and Phosphorous by 103 lbs/yr
- Infiltration of stormwater and county drain outputs will decrease the impact of pollutants on Thompson Creek
- Enhances green space, shade coverage, and recreation opportunities
- Project provides benefits to nearby disadvantaged communities
- 2 meetings and an online forum facilitated community input
- 2 letters of support from community groups that use Larkin Park



Total funding request: \$25,000,000 (Construction)

San Gabriel Reservoir Post-Bridge Fire Emergency Restoration Project

Project Lead: Los Angeles County Flood Control District

Removal of 5 million cy of sediment from San Gabriel Reservoir & placement at Burro Canyon Sediment Placement Site over 5 years (2027-2032).

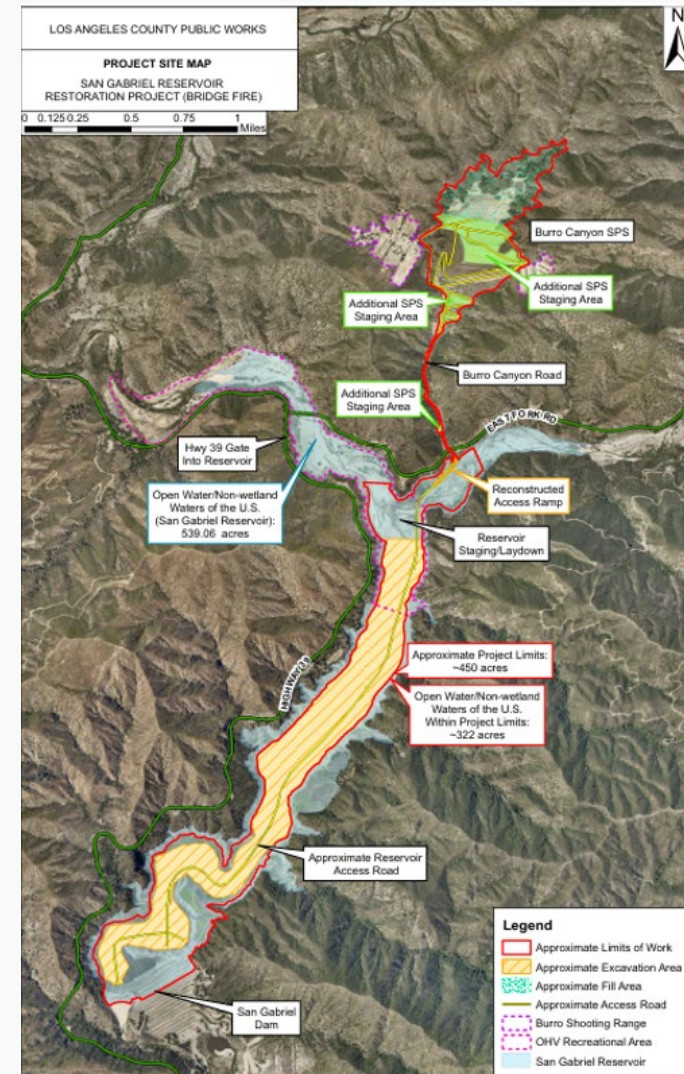

Location: 9700 San Gabriel Canyon Rd, Azusa, CA

Timeline: Construction complete 12/2031

Key Highlights

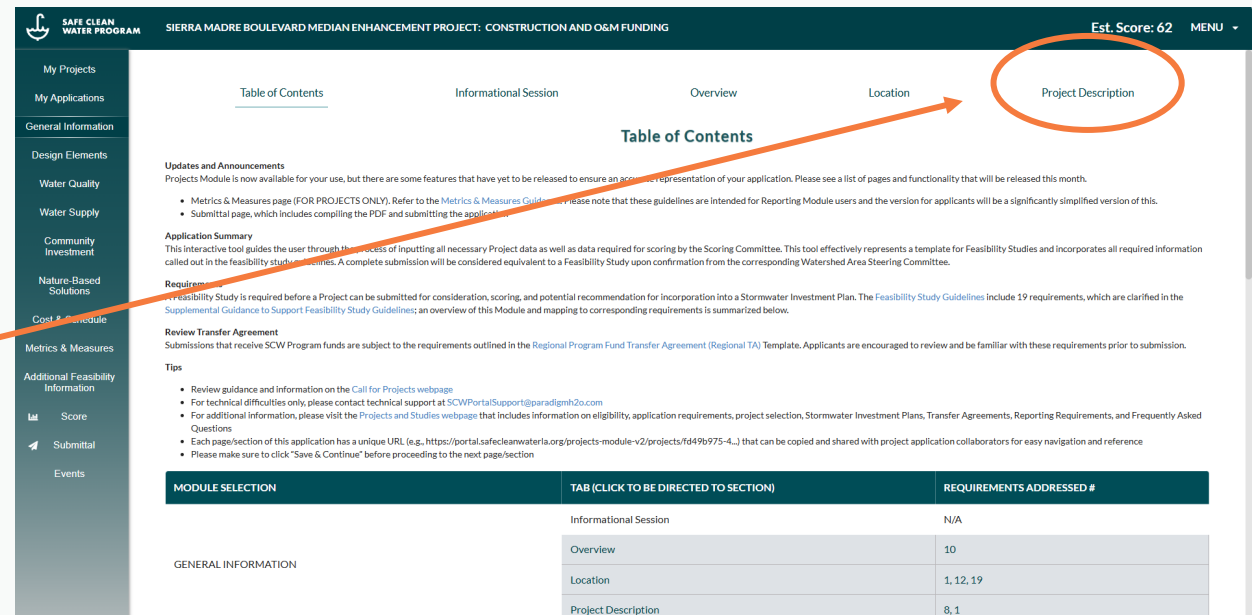
- Average of 7,310 acre-feet stormwater captured annually
- Dam releases water to spreading grounds for groundwater recharge
- Removes sediment, debris, and trash from reservoir from the Bridge Fire, reducing contaminants in water supply
- Restored dam capacity will increase stormwater capture, water supply, flood control, and hydroelectric energy generation
- Supports ecological resilience, open space protection, and public recreation opportunities around the dam
- LACFCD will match SCWP funding and supplement remaining costs
