I would like to make public comment in support of the Pacoima Beautiful's Pacoima Wash Greenway SCW application for design funds submitted in July.

Hello. My name is Robin Mark, I am Director of Partnerships at SALT Landscape Architects. I have worked in partnership with Pacoima Beautiful for almost 10 years and during that time the Pacoima Wash Greenway has been a top priority for PB and the Pacoima community at large.

Community engagement has been on-going for 17 years - because this project has been conceived of by the community, and is being implemented by the community.

PB has dedicated time and energy into developing a plan for the Pacoima Wash that will serve residents. As folks know, Pacoima and the Wash is in a part of the City desperately lacking access to open space, equitable distribution of shade, and safe places for people and families to spend time outside. The Pacoima Wash Greenway is one part of the solution to these issues. PB has put together an application to address this need and push the project forward. They have secured millions in grant and philanthropic funding to do this work, and this application to the SCWP is another effort to push the project forward.

As folks can imagine, there is not one funding source that is going to pay for the overall retrofit of the entire Pacoima Wash to become the verdant landscape residents have envisioned. Thus, PB is doing the work to chip away at the overall effort and design and implement that vision in phases. This SCWP application is one of those efforts to bring the money and resources to this critically important community led project.
