



Alondra Park Multi-Benefit Stormwater Capture Project

○ Project Scope

The project will divert urban and stormwater runoff from surrounding areas including unincorporated communities and the cities of El Segundo, Hawthorne, Lawndale, Manhattan Beach, and Redondo Beach into an underground storage and water treatment system for landscape irrigation reuse. The project will also include above ground landscaping, Low-Impact-Development features, and educational signage.

○ Project Benefits

The project will improve the quality of our rivers and ocean, increase local water supply through the use of an alternate source of water, and provide educational and outreach opportunities.
