Carson Stormwater and Runoff Capture Project at Carriage Crest Park (City of Carson)

Project Scope

The Carson Stormwater and Runoff Capture Project at Carriage Crest Park Project is a collaborative project between the County of Los Angeles and the City of Carson. The project provides an opportunity for the County and the City to address stormwater quality in a cost-effective manner by partnering on a single project in lieu of constructing and maintaining separate projects.

The project will divert urban and stormwater runoff from the unincorporated County area of West Carson and the City of Carson into an underground detention basin underneath the park fields. The runoff will then be sent to the Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County's Joint Water Pollution Control Plant for further treatment.

Project Benefits

The project will improve the quality of Wilmington Drain and Machado Lake.
