1. Welcome and Introductions

Mr. CJ Caluag of the District called the Upper Los Angeles River (ULAR) WASC meeting to order.

District staff facilitated roll call voting for attendance and quorum was established. He provided an overview of the WebEx interface and provided instructions for a member of the public to provide a comment during the Public Comment Period.

2. Approval of Meeting Minutes from November 4, 2020

The District uploaded a copy of the meeting minutes from the November 4th meeting, and asked the WASC members for comments or revisions, there were none. The WASC did a roll call vote to approve the meeting minutes from November 4, 2020 (unanimous).

3. Committee Member and District Updates

For the District, a few items were discussed regarding projects scoring. The Scoring Committee began reviewing projects submitted to the Infrastructure Program for official scoring at their upcoming meetings and will invite applicants to provide additional details as needed.

As discussed at the last meeting, there were 67 Watershed Coordinator proposals from 21 different applicants. Phase 1 evaluation was done by LA County Public Works' Business Relations and Contracts

Division. Phase 2 of the Watershed Coordinator selection process involves the WASC interviews, which are being conducted in today's meeting, with the Watershed Coordinator selection happening in January and the on-boarding of the Watershed Coordinators in February.

The District distributed 86 municipal Transfer Agreements to the cities and unincorporated LA County. A reminder to each agency was provided to execute and submit their signed Transfer Agreements, the resolution, and their Annual Plans as soon as possible. The Scope of work is due 45 days after LA County Board of Supervisors adoption, which was the end of November and accompanied by California Environmental Quality Act evaluation and determination.

Mr. David Nahai asked when the WASC will be able to start reviewing the projects. District staff mentioned they are anticipating starting in January or February.

i) Process Overview

During the interview process, District staff will read each interview question out loud and have the questions presented on the screen. All proposers received questions in advance, and all will be asked the same set of questions. Committee members were sent the set of questions, note-taking sheet, the Watershed Coordinator roles/responsibilities, and each Watershed Coordinator's Statement of Qualifications. It is highly advised to write notes to remember critical information when voting at the next meeting. If the Committee member present at today's meeting will not be present at the following meeting the meeting notes should be passed onto the alternate member for voting purposes. If any Committee Members must recuse themselves from the Watershed Coordinator selection process. The selection process and voting will occur during the January meeting.

He noted Watershed Coordinators will be invited to answer questions any follow up questions from the committee. The committee can reflect on the information presented. In addition, Project applicants may be invited to provide presentations on their IP/TRP/SS project.

Our ancestral land covers a large portion of this committee's watershed boundaries. Therefore, it is my hopes for our Fernandeño Tataviam Tribal Government to be engaged and given the opportunity to participate in the Safe Clean Water Program. Of the people you are interviewing today I can attest that Carlos Moran from the Council for Watershed Health is the right person to meaningfully and authentically engage with my Tribe. I have worked with Carlos during community activations to give away hundreds of fruit trees to local residents, plant trees in our lands and connect LA youth with indigenous elders from the Amazon Forest to address climate change. I strongly support Carlos Moran and the Council for Watershed Health team to be our Watershed Coordinators for the Los Angeles County s Safe Clean Water Program.
