Project Summary: Agoura Hills City Wide Low Flow Diversion Project

Agoura Hills City Wide Low Flow Diversion Project: received a qualifying score of 74 points

- Lead: Agoura Hills City
- Collaborator: Las Virgenes Municipal Water District
- Location: Ten locations throughout the City. Sites were selected by correlating MS4-regulated storm drains with immediately adjacent sewers with suitable invert geometry to support gravity flow.
- Total request: Total 2,972,448.80
 Year 1 Funding Request \$1,368,782.49
- Timeline: Submitted June 2023
- Project breaks ground Spring 2024




Benefits include:

- Key water quality benefits: It is expected the diversions will operate 100% of the time during the dry season and will divert 10% of the first qualifying rain event (0.1 inch)
- Key water supply benefits: Will send 1,013 Acre-feet on average to Las Virgenes Municipal Water District to go through treatment at the Tapia Water Reclamation Facility. In the future, captured runoff could be directed to the Pure Water Project and become drinking water.
- Disadvantaged Community benefits: None.
- Nature Based Solutions benefits: None

Cost Share: DWR is providing \$1,251,450.00
