A. Summary of Activities

Provide a high-level summary of activities completed this quarter and progress made toward completion of the annual scope of work.

Combining a commitment to public outreach with ongoing effort to seek funding for meaningful water supply / water quality projects remain the twin priorities for the North Santa Monica Bay Watershed Coordinator program.

Fortunately there are two major upcoming public events happening in which the watershed coordinator was invited to participate, the Calabasas Pumpkin Festival and the first ever Malibu Watershed Fair.

Due to a concern that many members of the Viewridge Estates neighborhood are unaware of the upcoming Viewridge Estates SCWP project, coordinator worked to bring together a wide array of stakeholders to set up a Topanga Community Conservation Day to be held at Viewridge Estates. Event was set for several dates that got moved, ultimately ending up on November 4 which was cancelled the Wednesday before.

Coordinator shares funding opportunities with stakeholders as they arise and continues to work to create felicitous pairings, inviting both TreePeople and Santa Monica Mountains Fund staff, for example, to approach the Office of Supervisor Lindsey Horvath for annual SD3 community grants.
