Overview



Background: This community needs survey is a collaborative effort between Heal the Bay and SGA Marketing, and is used by the SSMB, CSMB, and LLAR watershed coordinators. Modeled after a more extensive WaterTalks survey, we encourage the public to take this short one-page survey at all of the public-facing events we attend in order to better understand community priorities and perspectives around water.

Question 1: What water-related issues are of greatest concern in your community? Choose up to 3.






Figure 1: This pie chart summarizes 204 individual responses from 90 surveys. Note that some participants chose more than 3 answers.



Question 2: What do you want to see more of in your community? Choose up to 3.




Figure 2: This bar graph summarizes 305 individual responses from 90 surveys. Note that some participants chose more than 3 answers.

The top two needs identified were park maintenance and cleaner streets. Here are a few specific locations survey respondents identified as being in need of improvement:

Park Maintenance

- Lennox Park (Lennox)
- Jane Addams Park (Lawndale)
- Greenbelt Park (Wilmington)

Cleaner Streets

- Gardena Blvd (Gardena)
- Imperial and Felton (Hawthorne)
- Avalon Blvd (Carson)



Question 4: List 3 things you like about your community (optional).




Figure 4: The above word cloud identifies the most common words used in this optional, openended response question, with the larger words indicating higher frequency. The top four most frequently used words were people, parks, quiet, and cleanliness.
